Stay three nights in Dambulla.

Day 4: Yoga & Cooking Class B D D Wake up early for a yoga session. Explore Dambulla's largest vegetables and fruits wholesale market. The harvest from the surrounding fields and villages is brought into the market for distribution to the rest of the country. Later we travel to a nearby organic farm to uncover the secrets of Sri Lankan recipes with a handson cooking class. Learn to cook a few Sri Lankan dishes like meat, vegetable and a traditional salad. Subsequently, enjoy a traditional lunch along with the dishes you have prepared.

## Day 5: Excursion Sigiriya & Minneriya National Park

Discover the 5th century ancient clifftop fortress of Sigiriya, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. These imposing citadel sites are known as 'Lion's Rock" and explore the ruins of ancient palaces, moats, shrines, frescoes and water gardens as you take in commanding vistas of the misty forests beyond. Afternoon proceed for a wildlife safari at Minneriya National Park. The Park is based largely around a huge tank (reservoir) and serves as an important gathering place for Sri Lanka's large elephant population. Besides elephants, Minneriya is also

home to many species of mammals like the sambar deer and sloth bear.

#### Day 6: Dambulla – Kandy

BD Today we travel to Kandy, en-route visit Matale Spice Plantation where you can see how herbs and spices are grown in their natural environment. Learn their medicinal value and use in Sri Lankan cuisine to enhance the taste of speciality meals. Later travel to Kandy and walk around the Royal Botanical Gardens of Peradeniya, these gardens have a long history dating back to the British Era. Now the garden houses thousands of beautiful plant species brought from around the world. Stay two nights in Kandy.

## Day 7: Kandy

Morning we enjoy a guided sightseeing tour of Kandy and visit the Temple of the Sacred Tooth Relic of Buddha an UNESCO World Heritage Site. Then walk around the Upper Lake area to enjoy the view of Kandy. Later visit Gem Museum and watch a short film on Gem Mining in Sri Lanka then explore the shop attached showcasing the finished jewellery. In the evening enjoy the spectacular Kandy Cultural Show.

Day 8: Kandy – Nuwara Eliya B T D Travel to Nuwara Eliya the 'Little England' of Sri Lanka, is set against beautiful backdrops of mountains, valleys, waterfalls and tea plantations. Visit a Tea Factory to witness the entire process of tea making, the rolling, withering, and packaging. You will also get an opportunity to taste a fresh cup of tea and buy some as a souvenir. Evening enjoy Hi-Tea at the Colonial Hotel. Stay overnight in Nuwara Eliya.

## Day 01: Arrive in Casablanca

### Day 02: Casablanca -Chefchaouen

After breakfast, head to Chefchaouen with a stop in Rabat to have lunch and take a guided tour of the city's key sights Chellah Necropolis, the Hassan Tower is one of the monuments which has a long history and was supposed to be the largest minaret in the world. Later, visit the Kasbah des Oudayas, Andalusian garden, and Moorish café. Stroll through the winding blue streets. Sip on a classic Moroccan mint tea at Cafe Maure, overlooking the Bou Regreg River. In the late afternoon, continue on to Chefchaouen. The rest of the day will be at leisure. Stay two nights in Chefchaouen.

## Day 03: Chefchaouen

After breakfast, embark on a half-day guided tour of the medina. Start with the Kasbah in the center of town and follow your guide through the blue streets that define this quaint Moroccan town. You will have plenty of opportunities to take photos alongside the blue walls lined

with flowerpots, or the popular blue staircase in the midst of the medina! Enjoy dinner at a local restaurant.

## Day 04: Chefchaouen - Fes

Today travel to Fes with stops en route to visit Meknes and Volubilis, the Roman ruins from centuries ago. Lunch will be at a local vineyard, featuring a tour of the property, wine tasting, and a meal made with that day's fresh produce. Sample the famous Moroccan vin gris (gray wine) and pair wines with locally sourced cheeses.

#### Day 05: Fes

Stay two nights in Fes.

Discover the medina's Jewish quarter, the medersas (schools), and the legendary tanneries, where ancient techniques are still used to prepare

Moroccan leather. Stop by the world's oldest and longest-operating learning institution, the University of Al Quaraouivine, founded in 859 AD. The medina visit will continue with a tasting tour, during which you'll visit three different food souks. Try Moroccan street food and Investigate traditional cooking methods by visiting a furnace where the water for the hammam (communal bath house) is also heated, and a 400-year-old furan (communal oven and bakery).

Day 06: Fes – Sahara Desert B D D Embark on an early morning scenic drive that will lead you to the golden dunes of the Sahara, with several panoramic vistas as well as a lunch break en route. Upon arrival, ride camels that will take you on a beautiful path through the tall sand dunes. Mint tea will be served as you settle in, after which you'll have some time to enjoy the camp and take in the peaceful quiet of the Sahara. Enjoy a warm Moroccan dinner under the stars, followed by a campfire and live tribal music. Take a few minutes to observe the starlit sky before going to sleep in the comfort of your well-appointed tent.

## Day 07: Sahara Desert -

Begin the day with a sunrise over the dunes and optional sandboarding, followed by a hearty breakfast and a departure from the camp to head towards the Todgha Gorges, otherwise known as Morocco's 'Grand Canyon'. After lunch near the gorges and opportunities to take photos, continue on to check in at your hotel where you'll have the rest of the afternoon at leisure.

Day 08: Dades - Marrakech B L D Depart for Marrakech with a stop at Kasbah Ait Ben Haddou, a UNESCO world heritage site located in the foothills on the southern slopes of the High Atlas Mountains, where parts of Game of Thrones were filmed. After lunch, continue towards Marrakech on a scenic drive venturing through the peaks of the High Atlas Mountains and back down on the other side into the dry flat plains of Marrakech. Arrive in the early evening to your riad and enjoy dinner. Stay three nights in Marrakech.

#### Day 09: Marrakech

After breakfast, visit the Koutoubia Mosque (the iconic sight of Marrakech), the Bahia Palace (a stunning example of traditional Moroccan architecture), and the Saadian tombs (an ornate resting place). Afterward, head to the medina for lunch, followed by afternoon visits of the medina and the souks. In the evening, visit the famous Djemaa el Fna square, which becomes especially lively at night. Dinner tonight is at your leisure to choose from the many stalls in the square.

#### Day 10: Marrakech
